





Words ending in /ence/.
Sounds like /uns/ spelt /ence/.

If the root word ends in /ent/ simply remove the /ent/ and add /ence/. Spell the root word and add /ence/. If there is no root word, simply spell the word and ensure it ends in /ence/.

Words ending in /ency/. Sounds like /unsy/

If the root word ends in /ent/ simply remove the /ent/ and add /ency/. If there is no root word, simply spell the word and ensure it ends in /ency/. Also remember to listen out for other tricky parts that may be spelt differently from how they sound.

Your child is currently exploring the suffix /ency/ in their spellings. It is important that you child understands the meaning of the word by becoming a "word whizz", is able to put it into a sentence (that makes sense) and be able to both read and spell the word accurately.

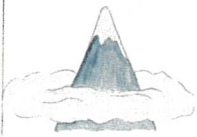
